WELCOME

Allow members to connect with each other before you start with Praise and Worship.

WORSHIP

Sing 1x praise and 1x worship songs.

WORD

Read Numbers 13:1-3, 20-33

- What was the instruction/mission/assignment that Moses gave the leaders going into the Promised Land?
- What was the report he expected from them?
- What was the report they came and gave to Moses and the Israelites?
- What was the difference in the report Joshua and Caleb gave?
- What does that say about our assignment from God?
- Let some of the homecell members share their instruction/mission/assignment from God.

Moses instructed the leaders, told them to “be of good courage.”

They came back with the fruit from the Promised Land, and declare the land is good, but they also begin to describe all the problems and challenges.

The negative spies were giant conscious, whereas Joshua & Caleb were God conscious! This was God's promise. Joshua & Caleb believed God's Word, and not what the challenges looked like! They operated with a spirit of faith!

Faith doesn't deny the reality of challenge or opposition; it declares the power of God in the face of the problem!
